**Design Assistants** to support the creation of the set and costumes for our youth theatre productions. This is a hands-on role providing opportunities to work with a professional designer to make set, props and costume. The role will suit students or recent graduates with experience of theatre design and making, and an interest in developing their skills and portfolios

**Assistant Stage Managers (ASM)** to work with the Stage Manager to ensure the smooth running of the backstage elements of our productions. This role will suit students or recent graduates with some experience in backstage arts.

**Workshop Assistants** to assist the Technical Programmes Manager in training young people in stage management, lighting, sound and props. This role will suit students or recent graduates with some experience in backstage arts who are interested in developing their skills while supporting others to learn.
