



Summary of Covid-19 Risk Assessment for In-Person Activity 30 September 2020

What we're doing:

- Maximum 15 participants (plus staff) in a bubble (or 'session group')
- Group size determined by size of space, with at least 4 square metres required per person
- Participants attending one bubble (or 'session group') should not attend a different session group in person within 14 days of attending a session
- Face coverings required for ages 11+ unless staff are provided with a good reason.
- Activities will maintain a 1-metre plus distance between participants, and staff at a 2-metre distance from participants
- LYT's Artistic & Executive Directors will keep up to date with available guidance from Public Health England, the National Youth Agency and through consultation with the London Borough of Lewisham and the Greater London Authority. They will update this risk assessment accordingly

What participants can expect when arriving at the venue:

- An LYT staff member (with clear face covering) will meet you at the entrance of the venue
- People arriving simultaneously will be asked to queue 2 meters apart
- The staff member will ask you to:
 - Confirm that you are not experiencing Covid-19 symptoms
 - Take your temperature with a non-contact device
 - Use hand sanitiser (provided by LYT) before entering the space
 - Put on a face covering (if aged 11+ and not exempt from wearing one. A clean visor will be provided if necessary/desired).
- You will follow a one-way system to access the activity space

What we expect of participants:

- Please walk or cycle to the venue if possible
- If you do use public transport, wear a face covering
- Please bring your own water bottle marked with your name
- Do not attend if you or anyone in your household has Covid-19 symptoms
- Adhere to social distancing for anyone who does not live in the same household as you
- Inform us immediately if you begin to feel unwell during a session

What we expect of parents/carers:

Please tell us if anyone in your household has a) tested positive for Covid-19, b) has symptoms of Covid-19 or c) has been asked to self-isolate by NHS Test and Trace.

You should inform LYT by calling or texting 07435 969 157.

Any young person experiencing symptoms or with a temperature above 38C will not be allowed to join the session. The designated staff member will follow LYT's usual procedures for contacting parent/carers if a young person has to go home, and will advise them to request a Covid-19 test.
