### About the Role

After completing your 4-week training, you will implement your new skills as a graduate creative by leading sessions promoting creativity, confidence, and well-being. You will be at the heart of delivering impactful drama workshops for schools across Lewisham and within LYT. This part-time, paid work experience role is perfect for those passionate about using drama to inspire others who want to gain valuable experience in the community arts sector.

### Key Responsibilities:

- **Workshop Delivery:** Facilitate engaging drama workshops in schools and community settings throughout Lewisham and within LYT.
- **Planning and Preparation:** Work with the Lead facilitator to prepare sessions, ensuring they are creative, inclusive, and impactful.
- **Mentoring Young People:** Inspire young participants by being a positive role model, encouraging their creativity and involvement.
- **Collaboration:** Work alongside other graduate creatives to share ideas, reflect on sessions, and improve workshop delivery.

### Key Requirements:

- **Passion for Drama and Arts:** A love for creative arts and an understanding of how drama can support young people's mental well-being.
- **Communication Skills:** Ability to engage with young people, communicate effectively, and adapt to group dynamics.
- **Team Player:** Ability to work collaboratively with others, both in planning and delivering workshops.
